

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS AND INSTALLATION

Windows™

To run the *Interactive Atlas of Human Anatomy* CD on an IBM-compatible personal computer with Windows 3.1 or higher, you need 4MB of available hard disk space; at least 4MB of RAM, although 6MB or more is strongly recommended; a 13" or larger VGA monitor with 640x480 resolution (256 colors minimum); and a CD-ROM drive. To install the program, please follow these steps:

1. Insert the CD into the tray and close the tray door.
2. If you do not have ToolBook® Runtime version 3.0 or greater on your computer, you will need to install it.
3. To install, choose **Run** from the Program Manager FILE menu. Type:

D:\SETUP.EXE

(where D is the letter of your CD-ROM drive) and click **OK**.

4. A Program Manager Group for the *Interactive Atlas* and Toolbook® Runtime, in a directory named MTB30, will be installed. Click the **Interactive Atlas** icon to start the program.

Macintosh®

To run the *Interactive Atlas of Human Anatomy* CD on a Macintosh, you need System 6.0.8 or later to run properly. It requires at least 4MB of RAM and also needs a 13" or larger color monitor (256 colors minimum) and a CD-ROM drive. To install the program, please follow these steps:

1. Insert the CD into the tray and close the tray door.
2. Double-click the **Interactive Atlas** icon to begin the program.
3. The Exam Record Utility must be copied from the CD to your hard drive.
